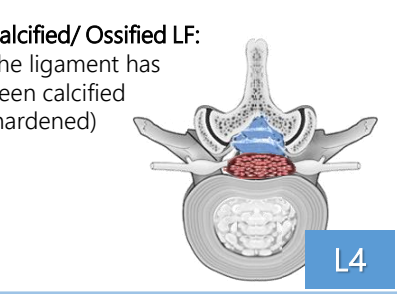
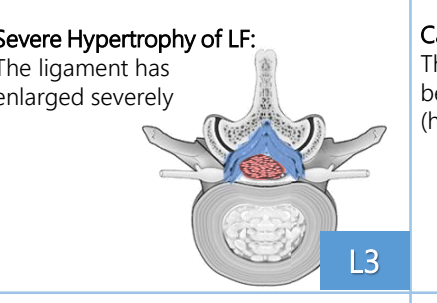
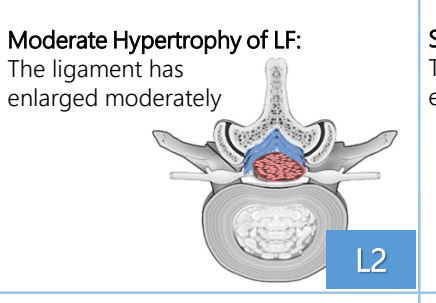
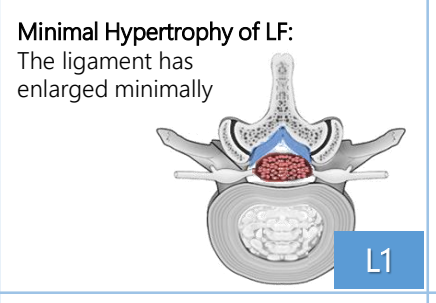
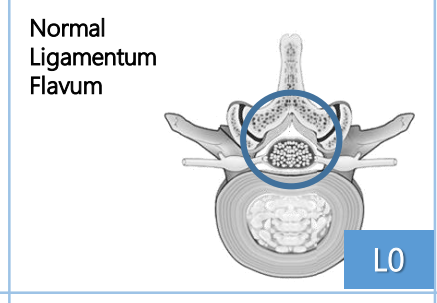
**1. Disc (D):**
